Trump talks up health care plan

WASHINGTON

"We're going to have insurance for everybody," President-elect Donald Trump told The Washington Post in an interview over the weekend, setting down a marker by which the health

care plan he has promised can be judged.

In the interview, published Monday, Trump would not say how he would accomplish that goal and also meet his other promises: "It will be in a much simplified form. Much less expensive and much better" than what's available under the current Affordable Care Act, he said.

Trump aides in the past have admonished reporters not to take his words "literally," which makes it hard to

know if he really meant what he said.

If he did mean it, however, Trump's promise would imply a significant shift from previous Republican health care plans. Nonpartisan analyses have generally said that previous Republican plans would leave several million people who currently have insur-
